
You MUST participate in the S1 Posting Exercise, IF:

- 1. You are eligible for secondary schools
- 2. You have applied to a school through DSA-Sec process and is unsuccessful.
- 3. You have accepted an offer to Singapore Sports School (SSP)
- 4. You are applying directly to Crest Sec or Spectra Sec for students eligible for Posting Group 1.
 - *Spectra Sec briefing at PAL Room after results are released*

You MAY participate in the \$1 Posting Exercise, IF:

 You <u>are successful</u> in your school application through DSA-Sec process and offered more than 1 Posting Group Options or a Third Language programme.

S1 OPTION EXERCISE - PROCESS

Submission of \$1 Option



Through S1 Internet System (S1-IS)

- From 11.30 am on Tuesday, 25 November 2025 to 4.30pm on Monday, 1 December 2025.
- 2. System is available 24 hours except on the last day, it closes at 4.30p.m.

Through Primary School

- 25 Nov 2025, 11.30am to 3pm; and subsequently from 9am to 3pm till 1 Dec 2025, excluding weekend
- PROXY FORM required if student or parents are unable to collect the result slip and certificate.

S1 OPTION EXERCISE - PROCESS

Submission of \$1 Option



Through S1 Internet System (S1-IS)

- 1. Print/Save and keep the Verification Slip
- 2. Re-login to the \$1 Internet System and confirm status of submission
- 3. Up to 3 amendments to submitted options are allowed.

Through Primary School

- Receive and keep the Verification Slip with school stamp
- 2. Check the details on the slip before leaving


Eligibility Criteria:

Posting Group	PSLE Score
2 or 3 Option	21-22
1 or 2 Option	25

- Students with Posting Group Option must indicate the choice of Posting Group during the school choice submission period.
- The chosen Posting Group applies to <u>all</u> sec school choices.
- Students should choose the Posting Group that offers subject levels that are more suited to their learning pace and academic ability.

CHOOSING A SECONDARY SCHOOL

- Use all 6 options with a range of cut-off points as choice order of schools will affect your school posting.
- Take reference from sch's PSLE score ranges from the previous year via SchoolFinder
- Students are strongly encouraged to include at least 2 to 3 schools where your PSLE score is better than the school's previous year's COP.
- Shortlist schools that offer programmes that cater to your child's strength, interests and able to provide suitable learning environment.
- Rank preferred sec school higher in school choices

OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Appeal for Review of Results:

- 1. Administrative fee of \$60 per subject (inclusive of GST)
- 2. Submission Date by 1 Dec 2025
- 3. Date for outcome of review: 17 Dec 2025
- 4. Submission and payment at: PGPS General Office

The following documents have to be submitted for the above process:

- a) Completed Annex A Individual Appeal Form (get and fill up at PGPS General Office)
- b) Copy of Official Receipt by school General Office


